AMENDMENTS TO THE Federal Gun Control Act prohibits any person who has ever been convicted of a misdemeanor involving domestic violence from possessing any firearm or ammunition. The law defines a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence as an offense, under either state or federal law, where the crime has "as an element, the use or attempted use of physical force, or the threatened use of a deadly weapon, committed by a current or former spouse, parent or guardian of the victim, by a person with whom the victim shares a child in common, by a person who is cohabiting with the victim as a spouse, parent or guardian, or by a person similarly situated to a spouse, parent or guardian of the victim."
